Prioritize capacity building and wealth building opportunities: community-powered solutions



Maximize savings from transitioning off of fossil fuels: using clean, cheap solar energy to charge



Move people, not cars: mobility justice means clean public transit, e-bikes, and more

Critical RD&D gaps and possible EPIC outcomes around equity and affordability in TE

- Balancing early participation in RD&D with creating unintended consequences in LICs/DACs with new untested technologies
- Needs-based prioritization and progressive financial support for lower-income participants
- Stacking and co-leveraging resources across agencies and funders
- Awareness raising of benefits
- Integrated service delivery
- Co-solving load growth, duck curve, resilience
- EV charging at multifamily affordable housing
- Subsidized public charging
